

Majestic Europe

Places Covered: Vienna - Salzburg - Venice - Rome – Paris

Duration: 11 Nights / 12 Days

Day 1: Vienna

On arrival in Vienna, you will be transferred to the hotel. Rest of the day free at leisure to explore the city on your own.

Overnight stay at Vienna.



Day 2: Vienna

After Breakfast, proceed on half-day city tour of Vienna & **Schonbrunn Palace** tour. Embedded into the baroque ambiance of the Palace Park of Schonbrunn, the Zoo is part of this UNESCO World Heritage Site. The Zoo was founded in 1752 and is the oldest existing zoo in the world. Through several expansions and additions fascinating habitats were created, in perfect harmony with heritage protection and modern husbandry management. These habitats enable visitors to gain stunning insights into the secret and tantalizing life of animals from all continents. You will be able to admire the Zoo's special attractions: a pair of Giant Pandas, Koalas, Giant Ant-eaters, African Elephants, Japanese Cranes and more than 400 species that can hardly be seen in any other zoo in the world! This explains why, in 2003, Schonbrunn Zoo was the most visited attraction in Austria, with more than 2 million visitors.

Overnight stay at Vienna.



Day 3: Vienna - Salzburg

Proceed to Vienna Station (on your own) to board your train to Salzburg, Rest of the day free at leisure.

Day 4: Salzburg

Proceed for a half day sightseeing - **Mozart City tour** - Stroll through Mozart's Salzburg and take a closer look at the main sights of this picturesque city. See the Mozarteum School of Music, the Marionette Theatre, the County Theatre, the house where Mozart lived, Trinity Church, the County Legal Courts, Nonnberg Abbey, Hellbrunn Palace where you will have a short stop, the Villa of Frohnburg, the Neutor tunnel, the Festival Houses, the Horsepond, Getreidegasse, the Church of St. Blasius and Mozart Square. You will also receive a ticket for a funicular up to Hohensalzburg Fortress, which dates back to the 11th century and is the largest in Europe, from where you will be able to enjoy a breathtaking panoramic view of the city.

Overnight stay at Salzburg.



Day 5: Salzburg - Venice

Proceed to Salzburg station (on your own) to board your train to Venice (A Journey of approx 6.5 hrs)

Overnight stay at Venice.

Day 6: Venice

Morning day free at leisure. In the afternoon proceed on a half-day tour of the three islands **Murano, Burano & Torcello**. After sailing past the island of San Giorgio Maggiore, the Public Gardens, the tip of Sant'Elena and the famous Lido beach resort, the boat arrives in Murano, known throughout the world for its glass manufacturing industry. Here we stop for around 40 minutes to visit to one of the factories. The second stop is at the picturesque island of Burano, famous not only for its lace but also for the fishermen's houses painted in bright colors. The stop will last about 30 minutes. Then after a short cruise, we reach Torcello, the earliest centre of civilization in the estuary. Only the Cathedral with its magnificent mosaics and the church of Santa Fosca remain as testimony of its former glory. The stop will be for about 30 minutes then we return to St.Mark's Square.



Overnight stay at Venice.

Day 7: Venice - Rome

Proceed to Venice Station (on your own) to board your train to Rome. Rest of the day is free at leisure.

Overnight stay at Rome.

Day 8: Rome

After Breakfast, proceed for a half-day city tour to Ancient Rome. Crossing the Quirinal Square, with the Presidential Palace, you arrive at Piazza Venezia at the heart of the city with its Monument to Victor Emanuel II, also called 'Vittoriano'. You walk up to Capitol Square, designed by Michelangelo, and take in the magnificent view over the Roman Forum and Palatine. Afterwards you stop in front of the Colosseum from which point you can see the Arches of Constantine and Tito and the Temple of Venus and Rome. Passing the Pyramid Cestia, you arrive at St. Paul's Outside the Walls which you visit to see the site where the Apostle of the People was buried. Rest of the day free at leisure to explore the city on your own.



Overnight stay at Rome.

Day 9: Rome - Paris (Overnight Train)

Morning free at leisure. Afternoon travel to Rome Station (on your own) and board your train to Milan. From Milan proceed on an overnight train to Paris (approx 9:00hrs journey).

Day 10: Paris

Morning free at leisure. In the afternoon proceed for a **half-day city tour** of Paris. This tour will take you around all the main monuments of Paris. First discover the **Louvre Museum**, then pass by the Island of the City and see the famous **Cathedral of Notre Dame**. You continue to the prestigious Sorbonne University and the Pantheon. St.



Germaines des Pres and the Orsay Museum will also be part of the itinerary. Of course this tour would not be complete without a ride down the Champs Elysees and up to the Arc de Triumph. The **Eiffel Tower** will be the next famous sight and the last part of this small journey will include the Invalids, Place de la Concorde, the Madeleine and the Opera. In the evening you can proceed for an Optional tour of **Illuminations + Lido show**.

Overnight stay at Paris.

Day 11: Paris

After Breakfast, Proceed on a Full Day Disneyland Paris Tour. This is a one-day pass to Disneyland Resort Paris that gives a full day in one of the two parks. This includes transfer and return on board a luxury motorcoach from the centre of Paris to Disneyland Paris and admission ticket for Walt Disney Studios Park or the Disneyland Park. If you decide to step through the Walt Disney Studios Gates, let your imagination soar and immerse yourself in the never-ending, always fascinating world of movies and television. Yet by choosing the Disneyland Park Themes, an enchanting kingdom filled with fun, fantasy and discovery will form before your eyes, a world of make-believe characters, shows and attractions. Depart to the Paris Airport (on your own) for your onward flight or else continue your stay in Paris.
