

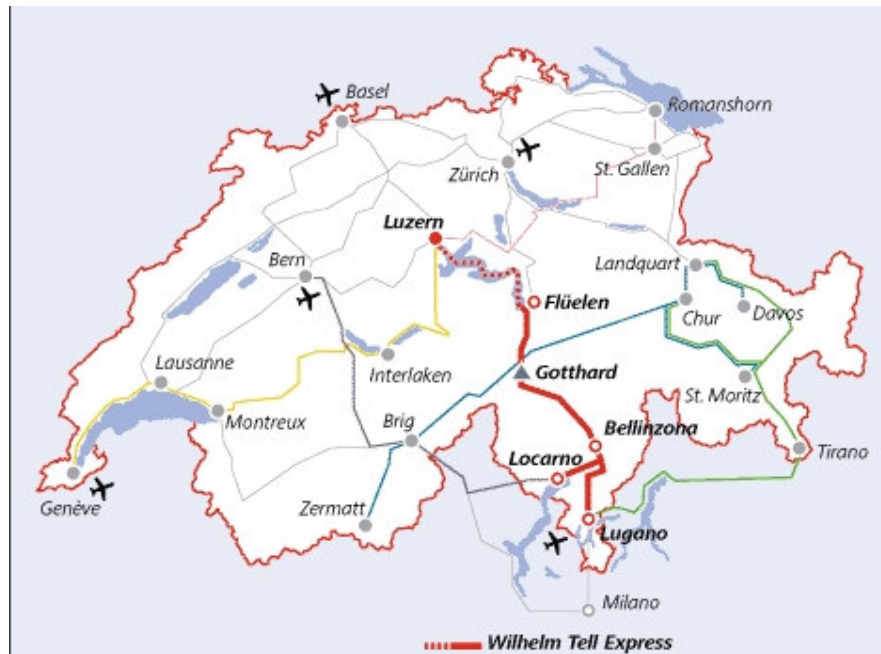
# RAIL EUROPE

## WILHELM TELL EXPRESS TOUR 2008

### Fares and Conditions

Available from May 1st, 2008 until October 19, 2008

The Wilhelm Tell Express connects the German-speaking central Switzerland with the Italian-speaking part. The trip starts out on a 1st class historic paddle steamer plying the deep blue waters of Lake Lucerne. On board, enjoy an elegant lunch. In Flüelen, switch to a panoramic train which will either bring you to Lugano or to Locarno. The train goes through the St Gotthard Mountain range, where a series of impressive switch-back tunnels will bring you up the mountain. The Wilhelm Tell Express operates twice per day in each direction (North-South and South-North) from May to October between Lucerne and Lugano/Locarno. Passengers from/to Lugano must change trains in Bellinzona.



### Tour Program

2 Nights / 3 Days

- Day 01:** Travel from any Swiss airport or border to Lucerne. ✈ In **Lucerne**
- Day 02:** board the **Wilhelm Tell Express** paddle steamer (reservation compulsory, not included in the price of the package) for a cruise on Lake Lucerne to Flüelen. Continue by panorama car on the Gotthard Line to Lugano. ✈ In **Lugano**
- Day 03:** Return from Lugano to any Swiss airport or border

⇒ Overnight in the chosen category of hotel including the breakfast

It is recommended to book additional nights in Lucerne and/or Lugano

**The Tour can be made in reversed direction**

Fares (in USD)

The basic package consists of:

3 days / 2 nights package in a 3 star hotel, based on double occupancy (breakfast included).

Swiss Card in 1<sup>st</sup> class with the 3 transfers mentioned in the program (incl. Half fare card for additional excursions)

Basic package does **not** include seat reservations. Seat reservations are compulsory for the Wilhelm Tell Express train from Lucerne to Bellinzona via Flüelen.

**The Wilhelm Tell Express tour is only available in 1<sup>st</sup> class.**

**No group fares are offered on the Wilhelm Tell Express Tour package.**

Children's rules

Child = from 6 up to 15 year-old included (up to 5 included: free of charge in the hotels)

Child up to 5 included sharing 2 paying adults room; special supplement must be paid locally for the breakfast.

Child up to 5 included sharing 1 paying adult room, the adult must purchase single room upgrades and then pay locally for the breakfast.

Children from 6 up to 15 year-old included, accompanied by a parent travel free on the Swiss Travel System network with the Swiss Family card (free Swiss Family card stock available upon request).

No Swiss Card must be issued.

**Please be aware of the fact that a child on its own in a hotel room is considered as an adult and will have to pay full supplement.**

**A special fare is granted only if the child is sharing the room with two full paying adults.**
